RE: FL's A61108 and A18671 -2007 Forest Stewardship Plan – Major Amendment # 2007-1

This is Amendment #2007-1 (Major Amendment) to the 2007 Forest Stewardship Plan held jointly by Monte Lake Forest Products Inc. and Gorman Bros. Lumber Ltd. as required by FRPA 29(1)(a).

SUBJECT OF AMENDMENT

This amendment is required for the following reason:

- To include an additional FDU (Windy FDU) to the plan to address MPB infested timber.

The following Results and Strategies must also be amended into the FSP in light of the addition of the Windy FDU:

- Section 4.2.2.2 Winter Survival of Specified Ungulate Species Ungulate Winter Range-Moose –Due to the Forest Health issues within this small sized FDU, objectives cannot be met for Moose Winter Range. Since the Windy FDU overlaps with Tolko Industries' Okanagan FDU, moose results/strategies will be maintained by Tolko.
- Section 4.2.3- Water, Fish, Wildlife and Biodiversity Within Riparian Areas (FPPR Section 8) – For the purposes of Section 12(3) of the FPPR – FDU Windy – Within 5 metres of S4, S5 or S6 streams or a W3 wetland, where no reserve zone is established, brush species, advanced regeneration and non-commercial conifers less than 9 cm dbh, and non-commercial stems will be retained unless cross-stream cable-yarding is the prescribed harvest method.
- Section 4.2.7 Cultural Heritage Resources (FPPR Section 10) -Add Windy FDU to the Results or Strategies as stated for FDU Pennask.

PUBLIC REVIEW

Public review has begun and is for a period of 30 days (period from April 28 to May 28, 2007) as provided for in section 20 (2)(d) of the FPPR due to the expedited nature of this harvest to aid in the control of mountain pine beetle.
